

Visibility - at St Combs

Should be assessed at the start of each shore watch and recorded as follows: –

Input Code	Distance	Description
1	<1 km	Bad: Cannot see to end of bay directly to north of watch site (1km). Do not carry out a Shorewatch
2	1-5 km	Poor: Can see Inverallochy to the north but not beyond. May just be able to see river mouth in middle of bay to south.
3	6-10 km	Moderate: Can see the bay to the south of the watch site and just make out Rattray Head to the south. NB. Rattray Head is about 10 km away.
4	11-15 km	Good: Can clearly see Rattray Head in the south.
5	16-20 km	Very Good: Will be able to see well beyond Rattray Head in the south.
6	>20km	Excellent: Clear views, no haziness at all.

St Combs to end of bay to north: ~ 1km

St Combs to Inverallochy: ~ 2km

St Combs to river mouth mid-bay to south: ~ 4km

St Combs to Rattray Head: ~ 10km
